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PURPOSE OF THIS GUIDE

This guide helps Idaho Report Card users—including educators, families, policymakers, researchers, and community members—understand Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) data.

The goal of publishing CRDC-related data is to promote transparency, support equity, and ensure compliance with federal civil rights requirements in education.

CIVIL RIGHTS DATA COLLECTION (CRDC) DATA BACKGROUND

What is CRDC?

The Civil Rights Data Collection is a federally mandated collection of education data used to monitor students' access to educational opportunities and identify potential disparities by student characteristics such as race/ethnicity, sex, disability status, and English Learner status.

CRDC data are used nationally to:

- Monitor compliance with federal civil rights laws
- Identify patterns of inequity or disproportionality
- Inform policy, technical assistance, and enforcement

Who submits CRDC?

- LEAs receiving federal financial assistance.
- Although some states submit the CRDC data on behalf of their LEAs, in Idaho, LEAs submit their own CRDC data to the Office of Civil Rights (OCR).

Why CRDC Data Appear on the Idaho Report Card?

The Idaho Report Card serves as Idaho's primary public reporting platform for education data. Certain data collected for federal CRDC purposes are reported through Idaho's state data systems and displayed on the Idaho Report Card to:

- Meet federal reporting requirements
- Provide public transparency
- Allow communities to understand how students experience school environments
- Support data-informed decision-making at the state, district, and school levels

Not all CRDC elements are displayed publicly, but many key indicators related to student access and school climate are included.

Report Card Requirement for CRDC Data

ESEA Section 1111 (h)(1)(C)(viii)

- (C) MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS.—Each State report card required under this subsection shall include the following information:
 - (viii) Information submitted by the State educational agency and each local educational agency in the State, in accordance with data collection conducted pursuant to section 203(c)(1) of the Department of Education Organization Act (20 U.S.C. 3413(c)(1)), on—
 - measures of school quality, climate, and safety, including rates of in-school suspensions, out-of-school suspensions, expulsions, school-related arrests, referrals to law enforcement, chronic absenteeism (including both excused and unexcused absences), incidences of violence, including bullying and harassment; and
 - the number and percentage of students enrolled in—
 - (aa) preschool programs; and
 - (bb) accelerated coursework to earn postsecondary credit while still in high school, such as Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate courses and examinations, and dual or concurrent enrollment programs.

Important Limitations to Keep in Mind

When using CRDC data, users should be aware that:

- Data are self-reported by districts and schools following standardized definitions
- Reporting practices may vary across years
- Some data are collected less frequently than annually
- Privacy protections may limit what is displayed publicly

What are the redaction rules?

5.2.1 Privacy Protection

- Student numbers were slightly changed to protect privacy (perturbation).
- Small random additions, subtractions, or swaps were made to counts.
- Most zeros stayed the same, except some results data (e.g., passing rates).
- Adjustments balance out at state/national levels, but school and district data may differ.
- Some data were hidden or adjusted to reduce inconsistencies; differences may still exist.

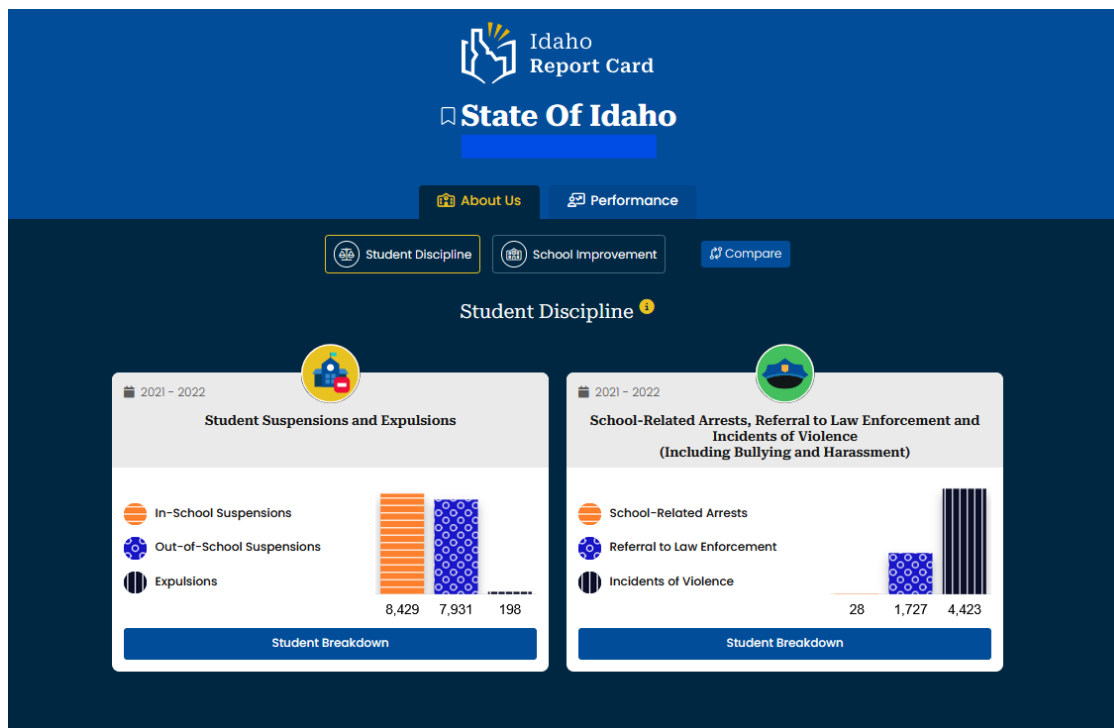

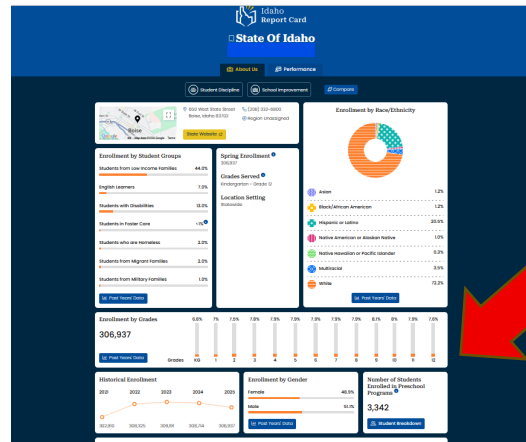

B. CRDC Data Location- About US- Preschool Students

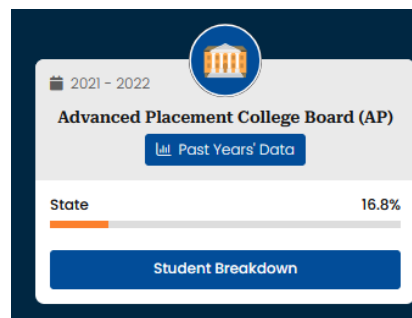
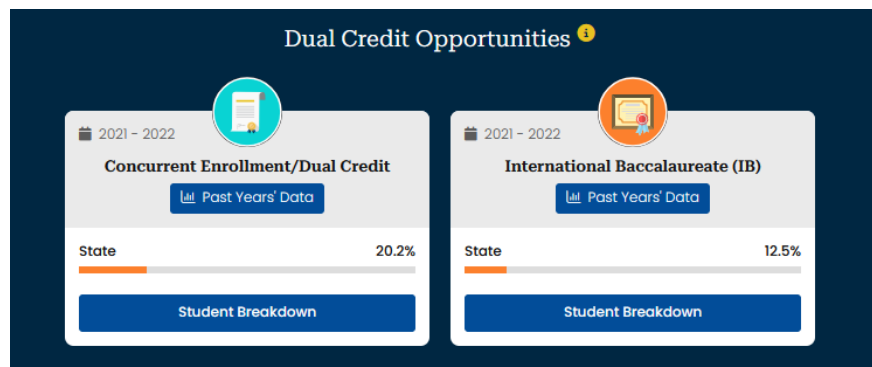
Number of Students Enrolled in Preschool Programs



C. CRDC Data Location Performance – Success Indicators- Dual Credit Opportunities

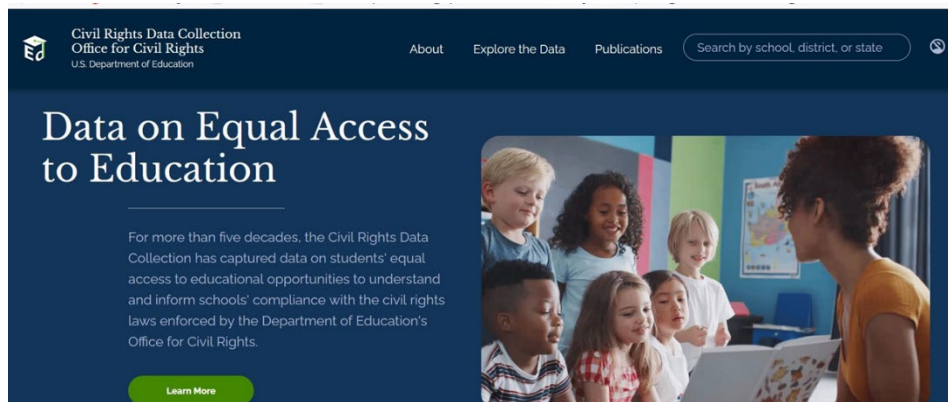

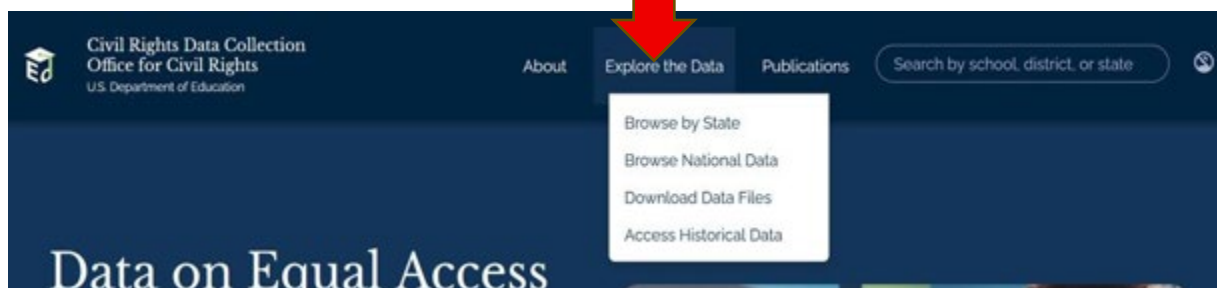

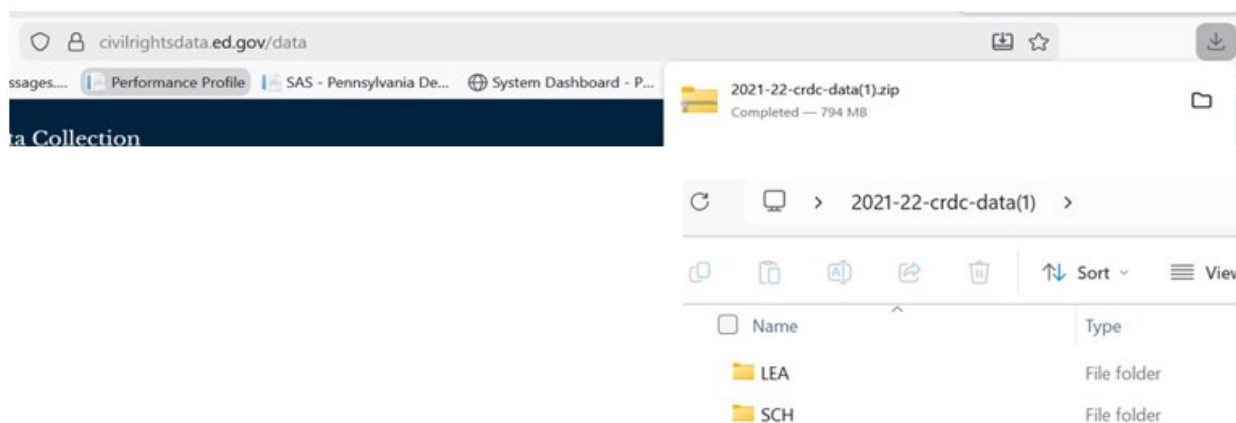
Click on the 'Explore the Data' menu, then choose 'Download Datafiles' to get the files you need. The download page will appear.

Click the link for "2021-2022 Downloadable Data Files." A zip file containing CRDC data from every state will download. Inside, there are folders for Local Education Agencies (LEA) and Schools (SCH). The files are in CSV format, which you can open in Excel or Google Sheets.

Also, note the other links for exploring the data.

To find school data, open the SCH folder and pick the appropriate file. Filter the data to show only Idaho. Then you can filter again to view a specific district (LEA), school, or piece of information in that file.

USING CRDC DATA FOR IDAHO REPORT CARD CALCULATIONS.

Open the Idaho Report Card CRDC Calculations (2026) spreadsheet to see all the calculations. In the Calculations tab, Column A lists the data labels used on the Idaho Report Card. Columns C and D show the data labels from the CRDC files. Column B explains how each value on the report card is calculated.
